**If you have NOT completed the required courses, please follow all of the below instructions:**

1. Go to [www.amisignup.com](http://www.amisignup.com)
2. If you do not have an MyAMi account, click on "Don't have an account?" Register.
3. Complete the "Create an Account" form.
4. You will receive a confirmation email. Click on link to confirm by entering confirmation code in "Confirm your account" page.
5. Enter Confirmation Code
6. Complete your profile by choosing the Industry Segment "Automotive Collision Repair" & Area of Interest as "FCA Certified Collision Repair Network". (You may need to scroll down to find the FCA option). **PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR SHOP NAME IN YOUR PROFILE.**
7. Once complete, Save Profile

**If you have completed the 2 required courses, please follow these instructions if you have not already done so:**

1. Log into your ShopOps account at [assuredperformance.net](http://assuredperformance.net)
2. Click on the "Business Certification" tab at the top
3. Click on "Certification Assessment" tab on the left-hand side
4. Go to Technical Capability and click "Begin"
5. Numbers 10 and 11 In the "Technical Training" section is where you will upload the AMi certificates (this is at the very bottom of the page)
6. You can get the certificates by logging into [amionline.org](http://amionline.org), clicking your name in the top right corner, and the clicking "Certificate" from the drop- down menu
