- Complete "Your Profile". Be sure to complete "Industry Segment" as "Collision Repair" & "Area of Interest" as one of the Estimator Designations
- 7. Save Profile
- Home Page will outline requirements and track progress.


• AMi Approved Business/Operational/Soft Skills Training

- Electives 20 credit hours of elective courses. These are available online and through industry training providers. Always check for "AMi Approved" logo prior to attending course. (Four on-going credit hours annually)
- Technical Damage Analysis Training
 - I-CAR[®] Platinum[™] Estimator or APDA must be completed and maintained.
 - Proof of completion required.
- Information Provider Training or Competency
 - Must prove training or competency in <u>one</u> of the following estimating systems:
 - Audatex Estimating[™] -
 - Proof of completion required.
 - CCC ONE[®] Estimating by CCC Information Services Inc.
 - Successfully complete Assessment Test in "myAMi" Learning Management System.
 - Mitchell Estimating
 - Proof of completion required.

AMCE (Accredited Master Collision-Repair Estimator)

- AMi Approved Business/Operational/Soft Skills Training
 - Core Competencies 22 credit hours of online courses.
 - Electives 30 credit hours of elective courses. These are available online and through industry training providers. Always check for "AMi Approved" logo prior to attending course. (Four on-going credit hours annually)
- Technical Damage Analysis Training
 - I-CAR[®] Platinum[™] <u>ProLevel 3</u> Estimator or APDA must be completed and maintained.
 - Proof of completion required.
- Information Provider Training or Competency
 - Must prove training or competency in <u>two</u> of the following estimating systems:
 - Audatex Estimating[™]
 - Proof of completion required
 - CCC ONE[®] Estimating by CCC Information Services Inc
 - Successfully complete Assessment Test in "myAMi" Learning Management System.
 - Mitchell Estimating
 - Proof of completion required
- Industry Certification
 - Must provide proof of certification and must be maintained
 - ASE B6 Damage Analysis
